

Methodists Will Open Camp at Caney Lake

Methodists of Louisiana will open the largest summer camp program in their history tomorrow.

A total of 34 camps and conferences have been scheduled over the state. They will be attended by approximately 2,500 children, young people and adults.

The first camp scheduled for the Shreveport district is the senior young people's camp which will open at the new \$75,000 Caney lake camp tomorrow. The camp will be directed by the Rev. J. C. Sentaffer of Vivian.

Two other camps which will be opened tomorrow are the Alexandria district intermediate camp, at Camp Brewer near Alexander, which will be directed by the Rev. Fred Flurry of Winnfield; and the Baton Rouge district junior camp, which will be held at Bluff Creek under the direction of the Rev. Robert Crichlow of Baton Rouge.

Four camps are owned and operated by the conference. These camps are the new Caney lake camp, Camp Brewer, Bluff Creek, and Seashore camp near Biloxi, Miss. Other camp sites to be used for summer conference activities include Chemin Au Haut state park near Monroe, Fontainebleau, near New Orleans, and Lake Arthur and Annacoco, near Lake Charles.

two Methodist youth caravans which will cover 14 Methodist churches of the state, beginning the week of June 26; children's workers' conference at Camp Brewer July 12 through 14; young adult weekend at Camp Brewer July 16 and 17; Guild weekend at Camp Brewer July 30 and 31; two Methodist youth assemblies at Camp Brewer Aug. 1 through 16; church school superintendent's conference at Camp Brewer Sept. 10 and 11; and pastors' school, at Centenary college, Aug. 29 through Sept. 2.
